Silverton is famous for its role in silver mining history and as the movie location for Mad Max 2, Razorback, Mission Impossible II and Priscilla, Queen of the Desert. Visit the Silverton Gaol Museum, the Mad Max Museum, the Historic Daydream Mine and the Original Silverton Hotel.

Silverton lies about 37 kms north of Broken Hill via Mundi Mundi Lookout.

OUTBACK WAY TOURISM

The remaining 1000 km of Australia's Outback Way between Laverton, WA and Winton, QLD will be sealed under a budget of \$678m. The 2720 km road runs southwest to northeast through the red centre and is nicknamed "Australia's longest shortcut."
